

Setup of Device When Wi-Fi is Available

It is necessary to set up your iOS device before using it. These steps or the look of the screens may vary slightly from device to device; however, they must be completed before the device can be used.

Initial Setup with Wi-Fi Available

Press the On/Off button on the top right edge of the device. If the device was turned off, an Apple logo will appear while the device turns on. The following screens will appear as you set up the device the first time. The initial setup screen will show the type of device (e.g., iPad) as shown in Figure 1 below.

1. Tap the right facing arrow at the bottom center of the screen and drag to the right to move to the next setup screen.

2. Language Setup Screen
 - a. Tap the desired language (see Figure 2).

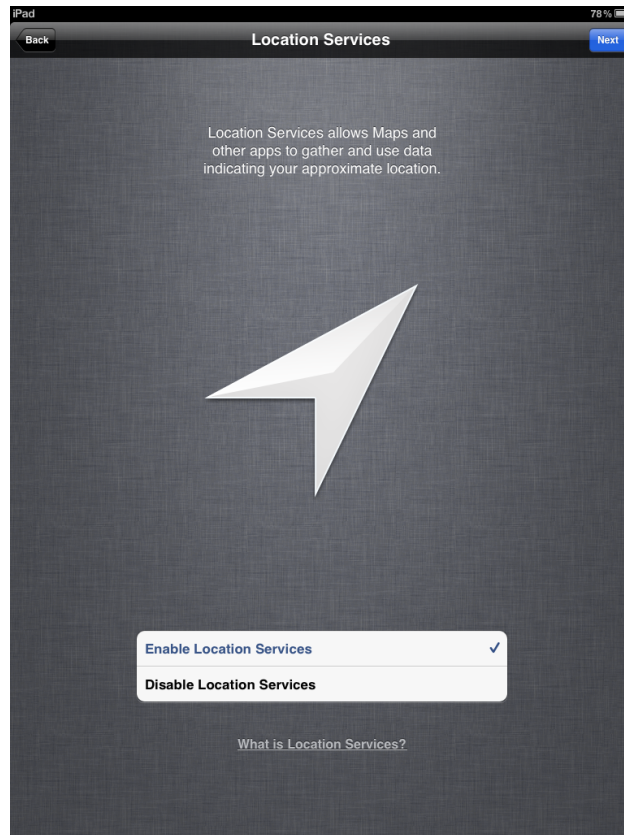


Figure 4: Location Services Screen

- b. Tap Next in the upper right corner of the screen to move to the next screen in the setup process.
5. Wi-Fi Networks Setup Screen

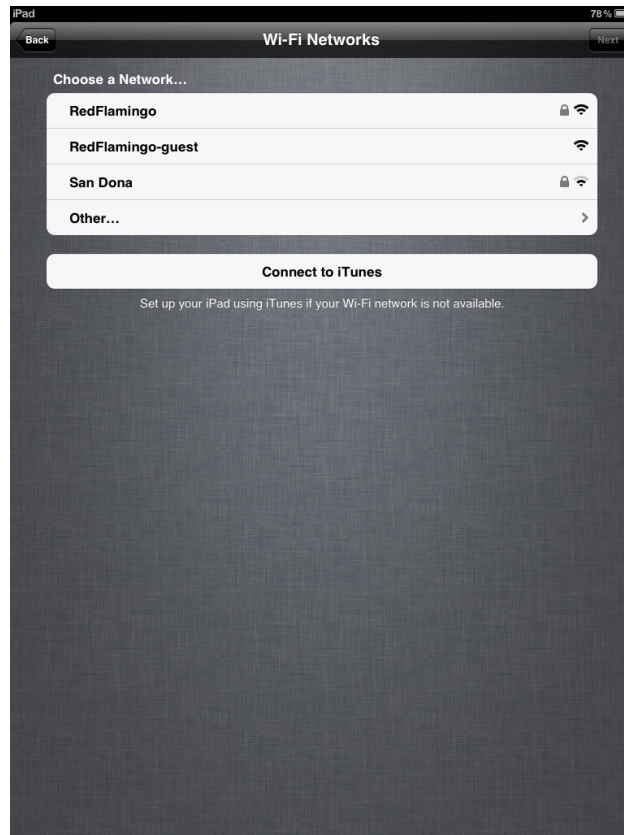


Figure 5: Wi-Fi Networks Screen

 - a. All available Wi-Fi networks will appear on the screen (see Figure 5). Secure networks will appear with a lock to the right of the network name. In addition, the relative strength of the network will appear to the far right of the network field.

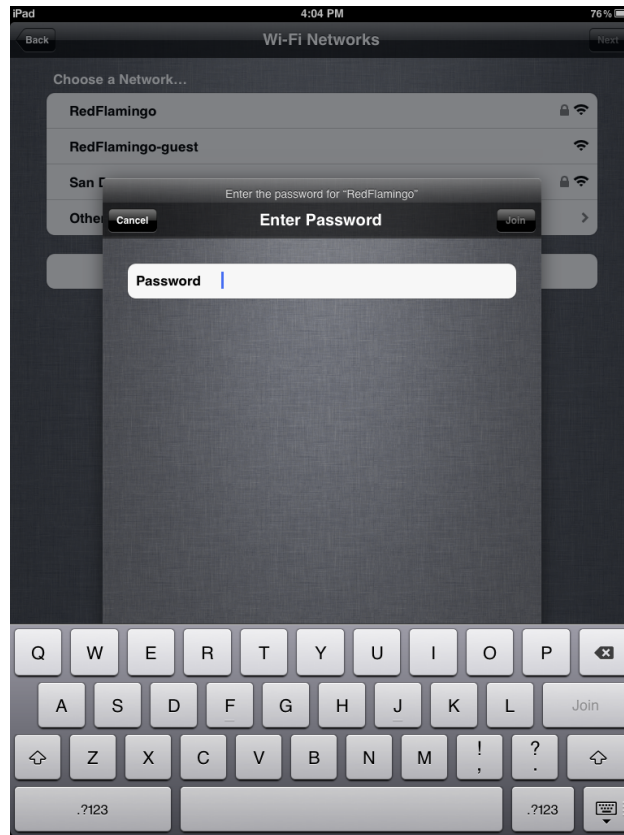


Figure 6: Enter Password for Wi-Fi Network Screen

- b. Tap the desired network. If the network is secure, an Enter Password screen will appear as shown in Figure 6.

- i. Enter the password for the selected network.
 - ii. Tap Join in the upper right corner.

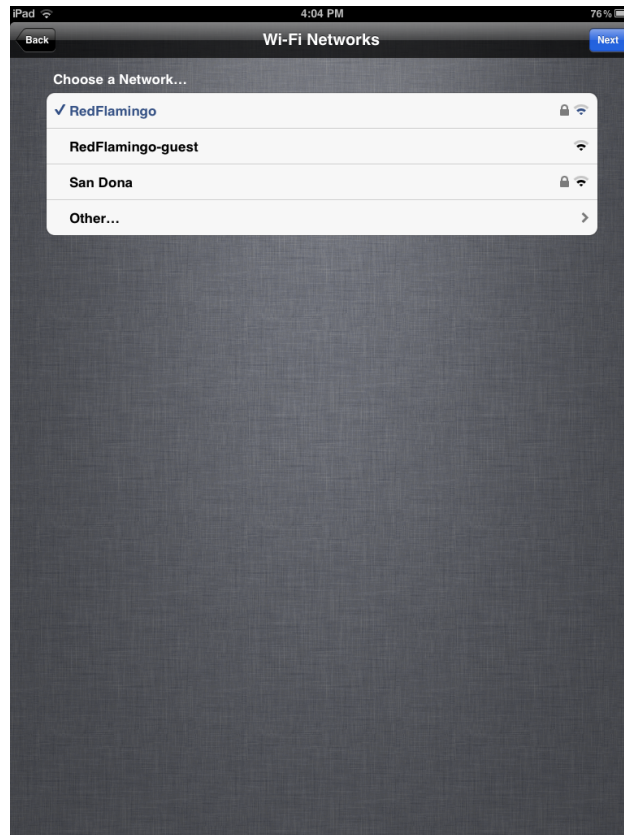


Figure 7: Wi-Fi Network Selected Screen

- c. Verify a network is correctly selected. The selected network will appear in blue text and have a check mark to the left of the network name as shown in Figure 7.

- d. Tap Next in the upper right corner of the screen to move to the next screen in the setup process.
6. Set Up iPad Setup Screen

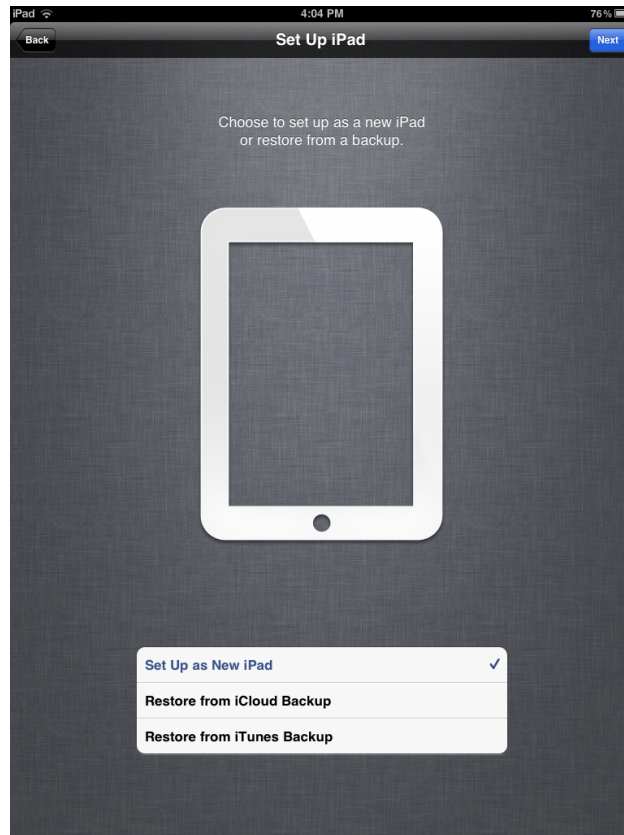


Figure 8: Set Up iPad Screen

 - a. Tap the Set Up as New iPad option (see Figure 8).

- b. Tap Next in the upper right corner of the screen to move to the next screen in the setup process.
7. Apple ID Setup Screen

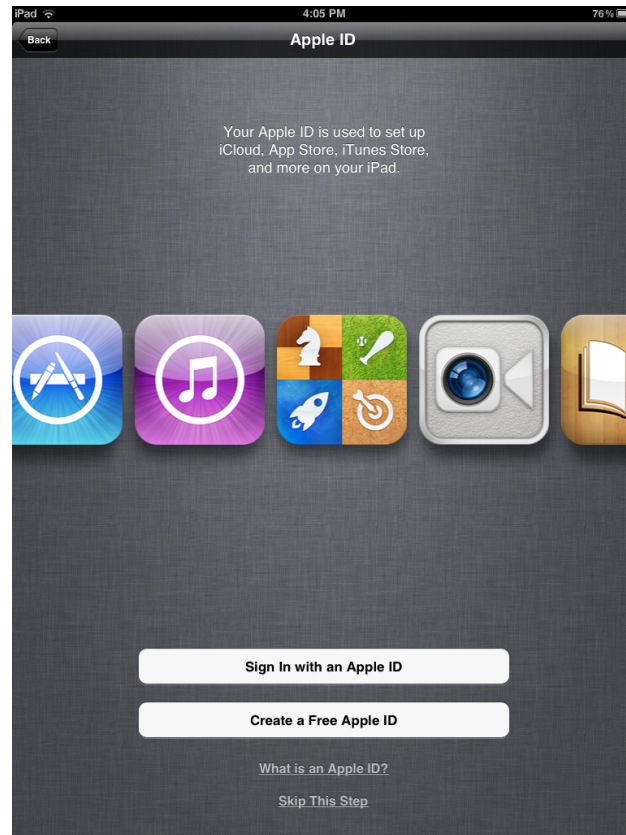


Figure 9: Apple ID Screen

 - a. Tap the Sign in with an Apple ID option if you already have an Apple ID (see Figure 9). This step can be skipped and completed at a later time.

If you do not have an Apple ID, you can create one from this screen. Creating an Apple ID at this point requires Internet access. For information on creating an Apple ID, visit the following URL:

- b. To skip this step and move on with the device setup, tap the Skip This Step option at the bottom of the screen.

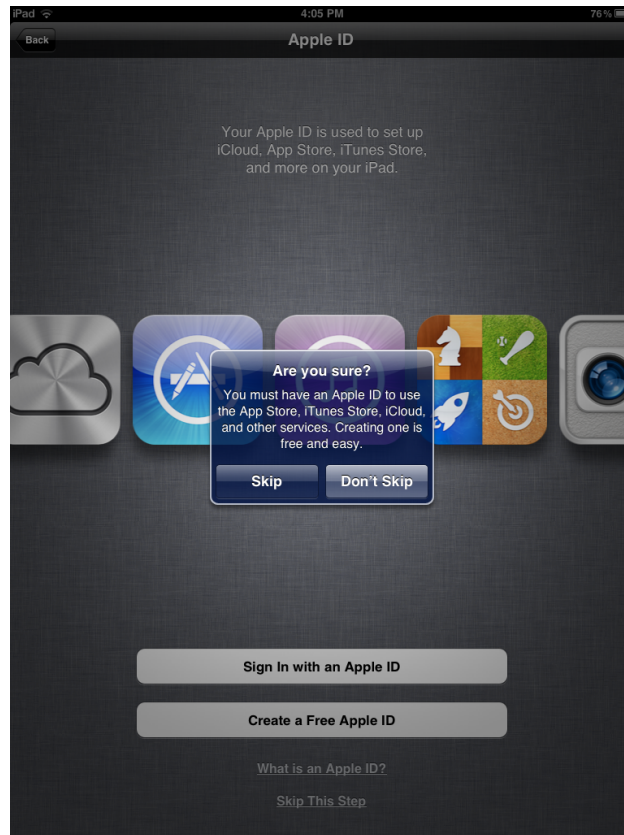


Figure 10: Apple ID Screen

- c. Tap Skip as shown in Figure 10.

8. Terms and Conditions Setup Screen

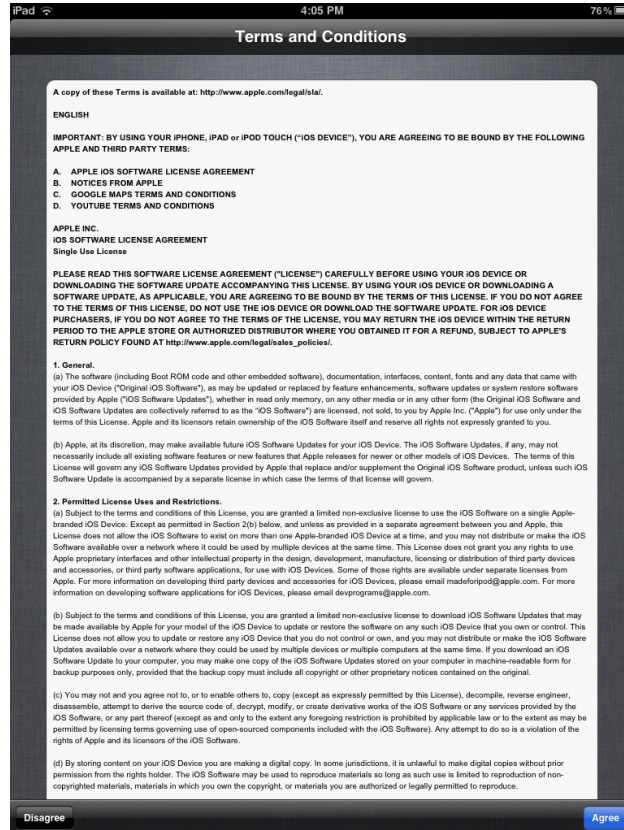


Figure 11: Terms and Conditions Screen

 - a. Tap Agree in the lower right corner (see Figure 11).

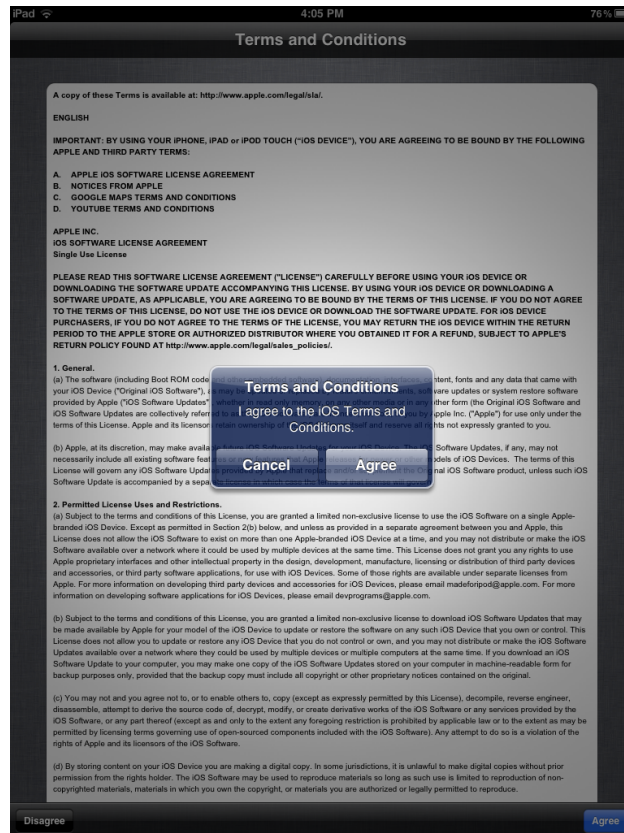


Figure 12: Terms and Conditions Confirmation Screen

b. Tap Agree again as shown in Figure 12.

- c. Tap Next in the upper right corner of the screen to move to the next screen in the setup process.

9. Diagnostics Setup Screen

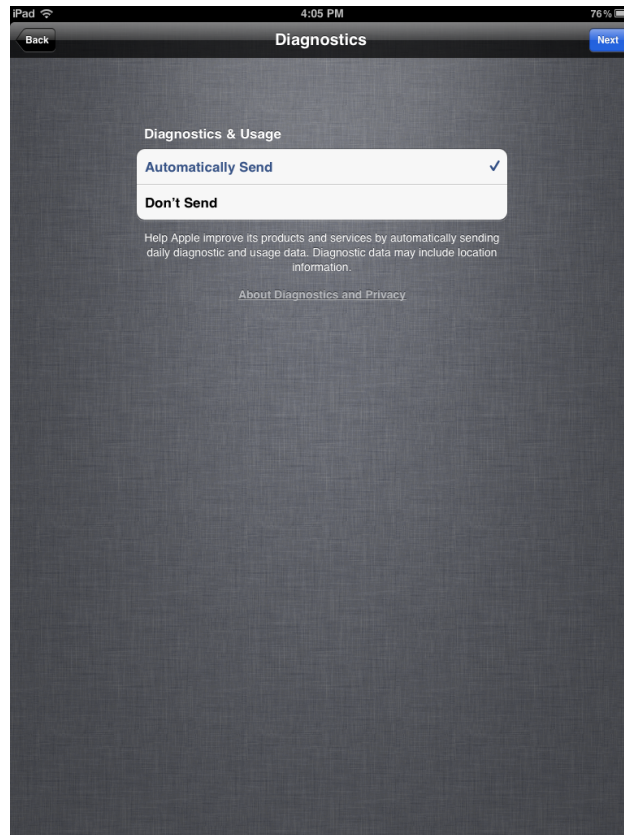


Figure 13: Diagnostics Screen

- a. Tap either Automatically Send or Don't Send (see Figure 13).

- b. Tap Next in the upper right corner of the screen to move to the next screen in the setup process.

10. Thank You Setup Screen

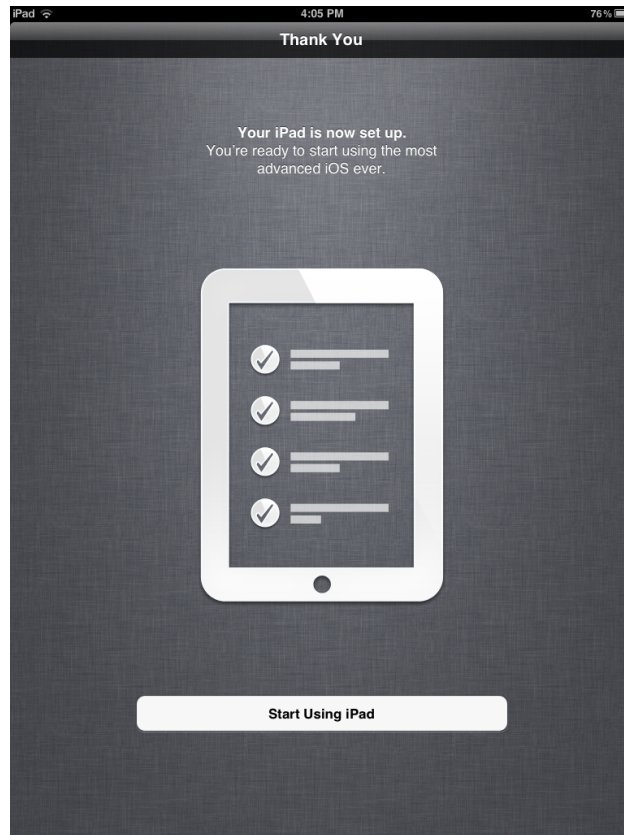


Figure 14: Thank You Screen

- a. Tap Start Using iPad (see Figure 14).
